Project Description: Construction Project WD-2794 "Sunol Long Term Improvements" consists of 3 major components: (1) Sunol Yard (a 7.6 acre corporation yard for the SFPUC Water Department's East Bay headquarters with new administration offices, shop and storage buildings and work areas); (2) Restoration of the historic Temple Road entry gates, and new resin pavement along the shoulders of Temple Road; and (3) the Center (museum and landscape). The Sunol Yard is a one story administration bldg. that will include a two office wings, locker rooms, a laboratory and a double height central circulation gallery; 3 prefabricated metal shop bldgs., 4 prefabricated metal canopy structures in addition to several other pieces of equipment that will be installed on site. Extensive sitework and landscaping will also be involved as part of the project. A restoration of the historic front entrance gate and neighboring walls will also be completed as part of the project. The Alameda Creek Watershed Center is a one-story structure that will include an interpretive display exhibit area, freshwater stream profile aquarium, history alcoves, watershed discovery lab, community room, restrooms, entry plaza, reception area, and administrative offices. The building is surrounded with a newly constructed native landscape featuring a 2.5 acre informal botanical garden. Restoration work of the Temple area forecourt, paving, and new stairs and ramps to the picnic area will also be completed as a part of this project.
